

RESOLUTION 2008-053

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO LEVY AND COLLECT TAXES OUTSIDE OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION AS AUTHORIZED BY A VOTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (STREET LEVY AND POLICE LEVY)

WHEREAS, at an election held on November 4, 2008, there was submitted to the electors of the Village of Waynesville, Warren County, Ohio, under the authority of Chapter 5705 of the Ohio Revised Code the question of levying a tax for the purpose of a street levy to be made outside of the ten mill limitation in the amount of 1.00 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to ten cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five years commencing with tax year 2008 as well as a separate question of levying a tax for the purpose of a police levy to be made outside of the ten mill limitation in the amount of 7.00 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to seventy cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five years commencing with tax year 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Waynesville after having canvassed the returns of said election as certified by the Board of Elections finds that 863 votes were cast in favor of making such street levy and 543 votes were cast against the street levy and that said street levy carried; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Waynesville finds that 894 votes were cast in favor of making the police levy and 561 votes were cast against said levy and that said police levy carried; and

WHEREAS, the tax budget for the Village of Waynesville for the current fiscal year has been prepared and is now in the hands of the county auditor.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Waynesville, _____ members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby levied on the taxable property of said Village of Waynesville a tax of 1.00 mills on each dollar of valuation which amounts to ten cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five years commencing with tax year 2008.

SECTION 2: That there is hereby levied on the taxable property of said Village of Waynesville a tax of 7.00 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to seventy cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five years commencing with tax year 2008.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of Council/Finance Director is directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the county auditor for his information and action.

SECTION 4: That the county auditor is hereby requested to correct the tax budget as required herein to include said levies and to distribute the proceeds of those levies to the appropriate funds of the Village of Waynesville.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need for the Auditor to begin collecting the levies at the earliest date allowed by law.
