

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-002

SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS BY REFERENDUM THE QUESTION OF ENACTING CHAPTER 38 OF THE VILLAGE OF WAYNESVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR A ONE PERCENT INCOME TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2009, Council for the Village of Waynesville adopted Ordinance 2009-046 enacting Chapter 38 of the Village of Waynesville Codified Ordinances to provide for a one percent income tax for a period of time not to exceed five years; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2010, a referendum petition, containing 154 signatures, was filed with the Clerk of Council demanding that the adoption of Ordinance 2009-046 be submitted to the electors; and

WHEREAS, on or about January 26, 2010, the Clerk of Council forwarded said referendum petition to the Warren County Board of Elections to examine all signatures on the petition to determine the number of electors who validly signed said petition; and

WHEREAS, on or about January 28, 2010, the Warren County Board of Elections verified that the number of valid signatures on said petition was equal to 140, which was in excess of the 102 signatures required; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to submit the question of the adoption of Ordinance 2009-046 to the electors pursuant to the referendum process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Waynesville, with _____ members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the question of adoption of Ordinance 2009-046 enacting Chapter 38 of the Village of Waynesville Codified Ordinances to provide for a one percent income tax, for a period of time not to exceed five years, shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Waynesville at the primary election to be held at the usual voting places within the Village of Waynesville on May 4, 2010.

Section 2. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

**PROPOSED INCOME TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF WAYNESVILLE FOR
A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED FIVE YEARS.**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Adoption of Ordinance No. 2009-046 enacting Chapter 38 of the Village of Waynesville Codified Ordinances to provide for a one percent income tax for a period of time not to exceed five years.

AGAINST THE INCOME TAX

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to immediately certify to the Warren County Board of Elections a true and correct copy of this Resolution submitting the above question to the electors.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 4.08 of the Charter of the Village of Waynesville, this Resolution provides for the submission of a question to the electorate of the determination to proceed with an election and shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
