

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-008**

**A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENTIONS OF VILLAGE COUNCIL WITH RESPECT TO THE OUTCOME OF THE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE REFERENDUM**

**WHEREAS**, Village Council previously adopted Ordinance 2009-046 enacting a 1% income tax for a period of time not to exceed five years; and

**WHEREAS**, through the referendum petition process, the approval of Ordinance 2009-046 shall appear on the May 4, 2010 primary ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to express its intent on certain action that will follow the referendum election results.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Waynesville, \_\_\_\_\_ members elected thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That if Ordinance 2009-046 is defeated by referendum vote at the May 4, 2010 election, Council intends to eliminate the two Streets Department full-time employees and curtail Street Department services commencing July 1, 2010.

**Section 2.** That if Ordinance 2009-046 is defeated by referendum vote at the May 4, 2010 election, Council will initiate a 2010 ballot initiative for an Income Tax or an Operating Levy, as determined by Council.

**Section 3.** That Council will await voter acceptance or rejection of any recommendation of the 2010 Charter Review Commission, including retention or change of the current form of government.

**Section 4.** That Council will retain the current Village Manager and Finance Director until the November 2010 election results are known with respect to any proposed change in form of government.

**Section 5.** That if Ordinance 2009-046 is approved by referendum vote at the May 4, 2010 election, Council intends to use all available income tax revenue to pay down debts and deficits while preventing any new deficits.

**Section 6.** That this Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
