**A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENTIONS OF VILLAGE COUNCIL WITH
RESPECT TO THE FUTURE USE OF THE LOCK UP**

WHEREAS, Village Council recognizes that the Fire and Police Museum Committee has done an outstanding job raising funds and completing major repairs and renovations to the Lock Up; and

WHEREAS, Village Council further recognizes that the continued use of the Lock Up is in the best interest of the Village of Waynesville; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to express its intent with respect to the future use of the Lock Up.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Waynesville, _____ members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. Waynesville Village Council wholeheartedly supports the efforts of the Police and Fire Museum Committee in its efforts to gather history of both the Fire and Police Departments.

Section 2. The Village of Waynesville shall continue to pay the utilities and insurance costs associated with the Lock Up.

Section 3. The Fire and Police Museum Committee shall be permitted to use the Lock Up for educational purposes as it deems fit, subject to coordination with the Village Manager.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
