

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-037

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOW BID FOR THE WATER DISTRIBUTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (HYDRANT/VALVE REPLACEMENT) PROJECT FROM ASSOCIATED EXCAVATING, INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Waynesville opened competitive bids for the Water Distribution Project on October 28, 2010; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of bids opened on October 28, 2010 indicates that the lowest and best bid was provided by Associated Excavating, Inc., in the total amount of \$47,750.00 (bid proposal shown as "Attachment A").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Waynesville, with _____ members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Water Distribution Project is awarded to Associated Excavating, Inc., at the bid amount of \$47,750.00.

Section 2. That the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any required contract documents with Associated Excavating, Inc., on behalf of the Village of Waynesville.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Associated Excavating, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$47,750.00 pursuant to the contract documents.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Starting and Completion: If awarded a contract under this proposal, the undersigned proposes to start work at the site within 30 calendar days after the receipt from the Village of an Order to Commence Work. The undersigned further agrees to start work at the site on a date to be specified in said order from the Village, which date will not be prior to that established by the calendar days stated above, except by mutual agreement between the undersigned and the Village, and agrees to fully complete all work covered by this proposal to the point of final acceptance by the Village in accordance with the completion dates established in Section V, General Conditions of this Contract. The undersigned understands and agrees that the Village reserves the right to defer award of a written order to start work for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after the date herein before established by the undersigned as a proposed starting date.
