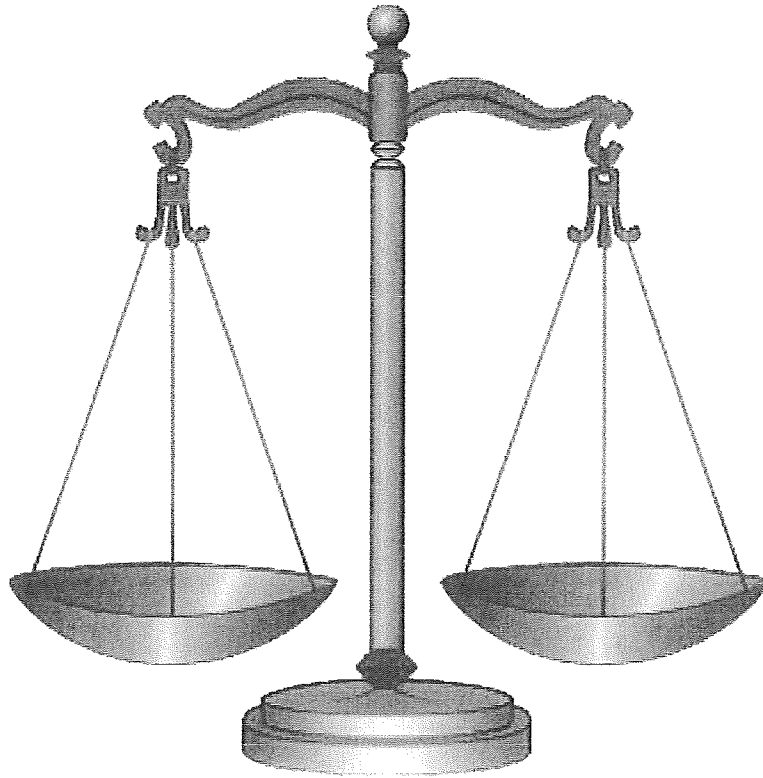

WAYNESVILLE MAYOR'S COURT

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Waynesville Mayor's Court is one of seven operating in Warren County and one of over 300 throughout the State of Ohio. Mayor's Courts have the authority to hear cases involving traffic and criminal offenses in alleged violation of local ordinances and state traffic laws.

The year was started with **131** open cases. A total of **514** new cases were filed in 2011, consisting of:

48 Misdemeanor Criminal
428 Misdemeanor Traffic
7 Criminal Traffic
31 Parking

There were also **514** cases closed throughout the year. Although the same number, the cases closed did not correspond directly with the new cases filed. However, a portion of those filed, **346**, were waived and closed, meaning the defendant paid the citation in lieu of appearing in court. There were **2** cases transferred to Warren County Court after the defendant requested a public defender. At year end, **129** Mayor's Court cases remained open.

Defendants that failed to appear in court or failed to meet their payment obligations were issued warrants, a total of **59**. There were **58** warrants cleared either by the defendant appearing in court to answer to the charges against them or by paying the required monies owed. As with the cases filed/closed, not all of the warrants cleared were included in those issued, despite the similarity in numbers.

Court personnel include Magistrate Jeffery Richards, Prosecutor Adolfo Tornichio and Clerk Stephanie Morgan. All staff completed training necessary to maintain compliance with state requirements.
